



Dear Colleague,

C TRAC was designed to treat Carpal Tunnel Syndrome. We realized Carpal Tunnel Syndrome is a mechanical problem in which the Carpal Tunnel is narrowed and produces pressure on the median nerve. This device applies traction to the Carpal Ligament, elongating the ligament, and increasing the area of the tunnel. Daily traction and ligament stretching for 4-6 weeks, helped alleviate symptoms of CTS as shown on research studies. There are approximately 1 million new diagnosed patients with Carpal Tunnel Syndrome in the United States every year and about 330,000 carpal tunnel release surgeries done yearly. Unfortunately, patients and many physicians believe Carpal Tunnel Syndrome patients will inevitably end up having surgery since conservative therapy often fails. The number of Physical or Occupational Therapy sessions is often limited by insurance companies.
